Rules:

- A. Health requirements, see general rules.
- B. Exhibitors must be members of their county's FFA or 4-H clubs.
- C. An exhibitor may show no more than 4 animals.
- D. Grade animals must have a certification of age, breed and ownership on file with show chairman prior to show (to be obtained from Voc Ag or Extension Agents).
- E. Animals exhibited must be the project of a 4-H or FFA member and registered animals must have registration papers in the name of the exhibitor.
- F. Judging will be done on the Danish System and money on the basis of (3x blue, 2x red, 1x white).
- G. \$500.00 Premium money awarded under the Danish System.
- H. All 4-H & FFA entries must have been produced in conjunction with an approved project.
- I. The top placing FFA & 4-H entry will be recognized.
- J. All exhibitors must pay front gate admission.
- K. Entry time 4:00 p.m. ET

Showmanship Divisions:

Ribbons will be awarded to each division winner. (No premiums will be awarded in this class.) Once an Exhibitor has won the Junior division, they must show in the Senior division thereafter.

NOVICE - For junior members 10 years old and younger as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.

JUNIOR - For junior members between 11 and 14 years of age as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.

SENIOR - For junior members 15 years of age or older as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.
